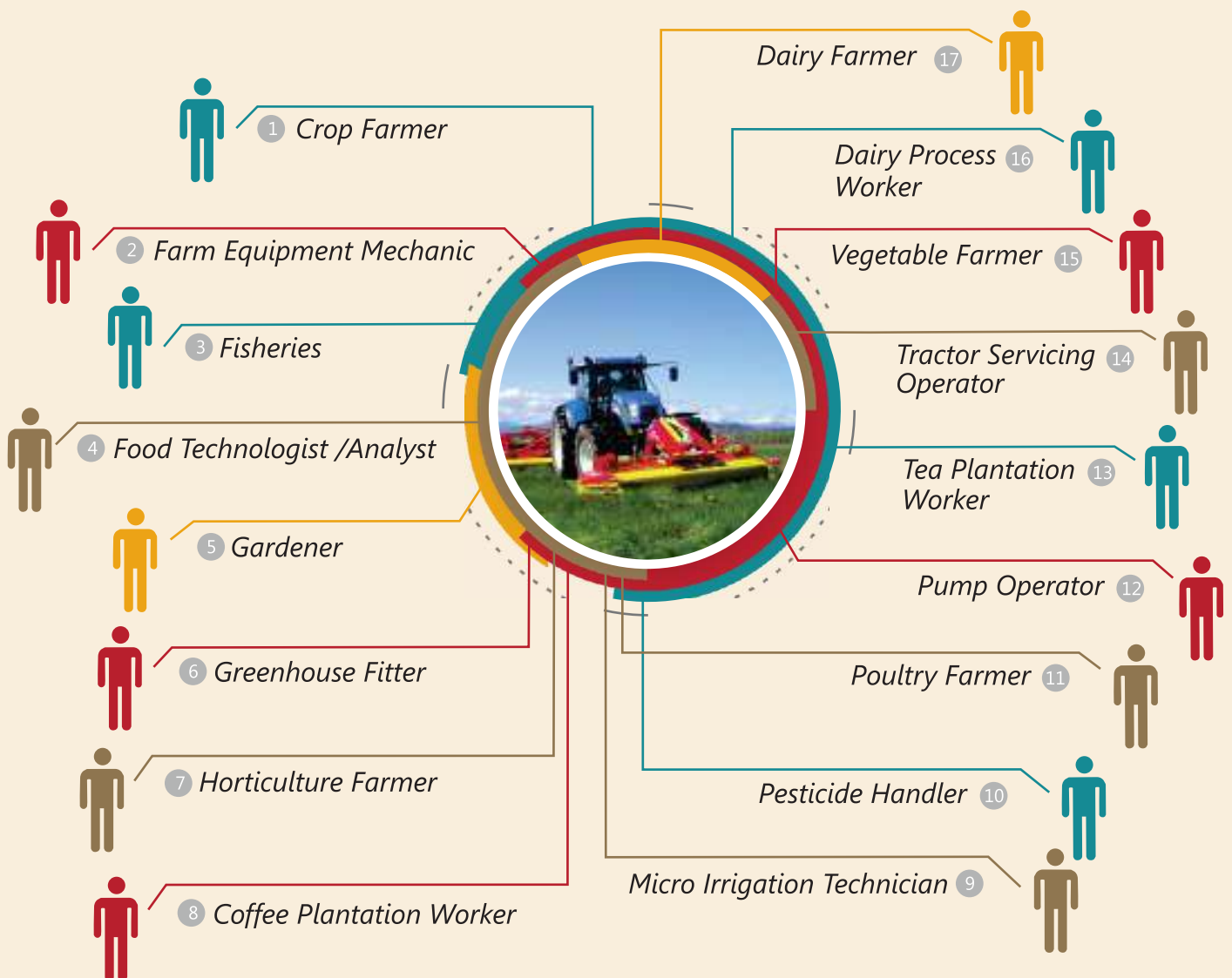

Make Right Vocational Choices**

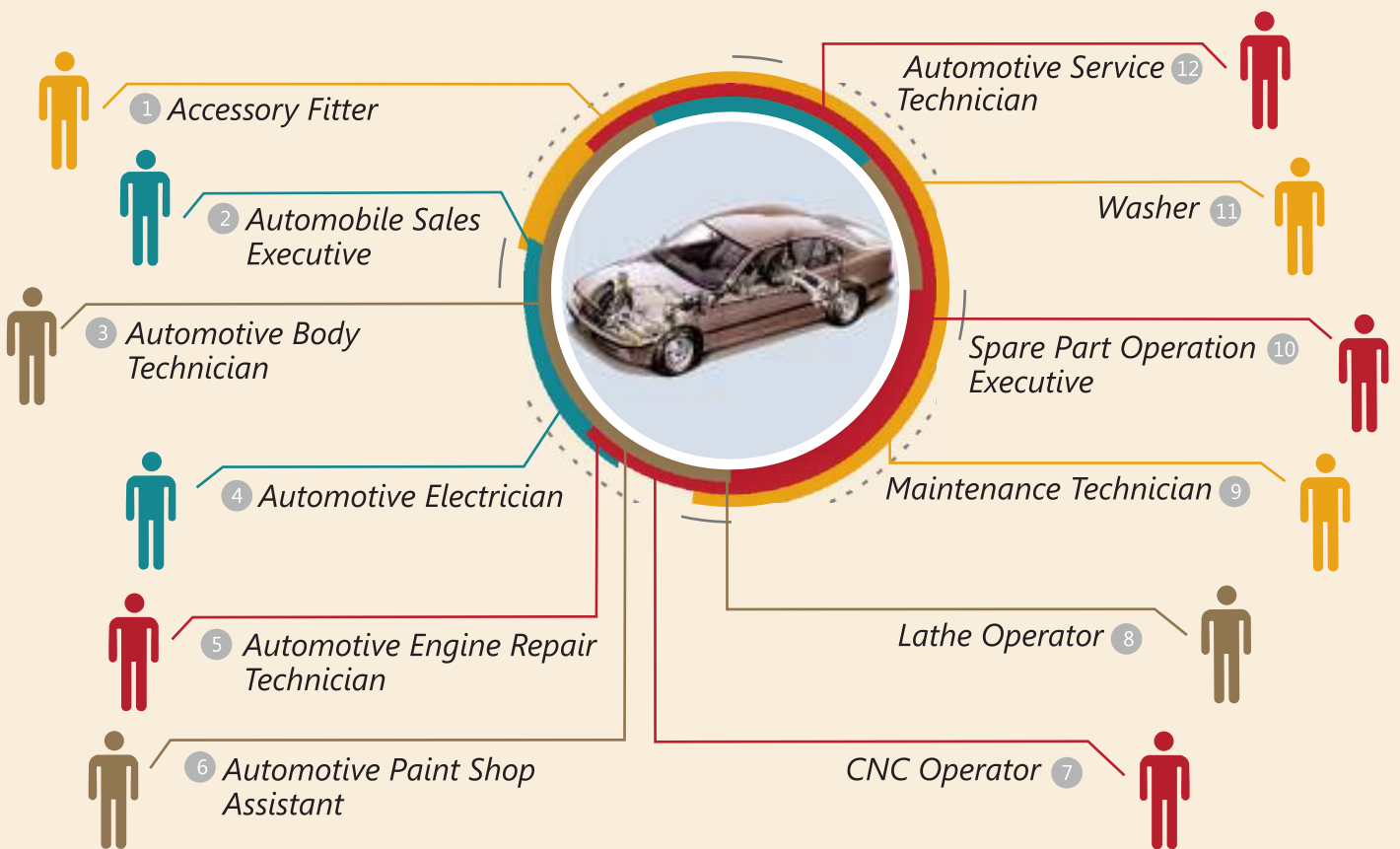
