


## Prologue

Mudaliar family.






Changed his Name to A.R. Rahman in 1989



His father R.K. Shekhar was a composer and arranger in Malyalam movies.




His **mother** Kasthuri (later changed name to Kareema Begum) always had a **huge influence** on the **boy**.





## Hard Life.

When Rahman was 9, his father passed away.





After a degree in Western Classical Music, Rahman worked on giving international perspective to Indian music.









